



Engineering / Right-of-Way Permit Acknowledgment Sheet

Please Read These Instructions Carefully

This form MUST be filled out by the Crew Lead or Field Supervisor

ACTIVATE YOUR PERMIT

Call 801-629-8990 to ACTIVATE your permit at least 1 to 2 business days before work commences. Email or voice mail messages do not guarantee activation.

SCHEDULE INSPECTION

Call your assigned Engineering Inspector right after activating your permit to schedule an inspection or on-site precon. Contact information is on permit.

Failure to do the two steps above will result in an immediate STOP WORK order

CONTACT & ACTIVATION

- If a contractor is found working without an activated permit or does not have an inspection scheduled, a **STOP WORK order will be issued immediately**, and work will not resume until an inspection has been scheduled and they have met with the inspector.
- If any work is completed, buried, paved or concreted without the appropriate inspection, contractor will be instructed to remove material so inspections can be completed.

DIRECTIONAL BORE JOBS

- On jobs involving directional bore, contractor MUST meet with the Engineering Inspector on-site for a pre-construction meeting 1 to 2 business days before work commences.**
- A video inspection may be required at the discretion of the City.
- All bore logs must be given to the Engineering Inspector.**
- Bore Pits and excavations should not be located within the Drip Line of any tree without prior authorization from Ogden City's Urban Forester (801-629-8369).
- Contractors connecting to fire hydrants within Ogden City's water system **MUST** have a city-issued hydrant meter as part of that connection. **Those connecting without a hydrant meter will be prosecuted for theft.**

JOB COMPLETION

- Work must start within 14 days of the permit being issued**, and be completed and repaved within 3 days on major streets and 7 days on minor streets. Winter Paving Plans are required during winter months
- Contractor shall be responsible for damage or destruction to property and/or utilities during the course of construction, including pipelines, culverts, conduits, cabling, asphalt and concrete pavement.
- Permit holder shall guarantee the materials and workmanship of the work for a period of 2 years from the time the work is completed.

****ALL SUBCONTRACTORS MUST BE LISTED ON THE PERMIT!****

If a subcontractor is found working on-site, and is **NOT** listed on the permit, a **STOP WORK** order will be issued immediately, and work will not resume until the Permit Coordinator has updated the permit and the contractor has met with the inspector.

I understand that failure to abide by all of the instructions listed above may result in a STOP WORK order or the revocation of the permit.
