Current Construction Happening Downtown

There are a few construction projects going on downtown that will affect traffic throughout the Summer. It is important for community members to be aware of what construction will be going on and how it will affect the community. Here are the current renovations happening:

26th Street Construction: The 26th Street Corridor is undergoing full-depth reconstruction between Wall Avenue and Washington Boulevard. This project includes upgrading all underground utilities, new curb, gutter and sidewalk, and new pavement. Ogden City has a dedicated public information team for this project. 24th Street Viaduct Project: The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is rehabilitating the 24th Street Viaduct from A Ave to Lincoln Ave in Ogden. This project will extend the life of the viaduct for an additional 20 years, improve drainage and enhance pedestrian access by converting stairs to an ADA-compliant ramp.

Ogden/Weber Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): UTA is working along Washington Blvd. to facilitate the Ogden BRT.

Emergency Preparedness Message: Code Red

Code Red is a free community notification system used by Ogden City to send critical and time-sensitive communications. Users register their cell phone number to a physical home address online, then emergency information notifications will be sent to their phone regarding their neighborhood no matter where they are. Downloading the Code Red app onto a cell phone will also give users notifications about their current location. Notifications may include information on missing persons/children, natural disasters, evacuation notices, wildfire alerts, public health crises, and other announcements requiring emergency preparedness.
