FAA SAFETY TEAM (FAAST) SEMINAR, NEXT TUESDAY EVENING, SEPTEMBER 21, 2021 AT 6:00 P.M.

An FAA Safety Team (FAAST) Seminar will be held in the OGD Airport Terminal Building located at 3909 Airport Road, Ogden, Utah 84405 at 6:00 p.m. local time.

Sgt. Weber's presentation will be on Surviving an Emergency Landing in the Back Country of the Mountain West. Actual aviation accidents and incidents

will be discussed and evaluated. Specific questions will be answered and discussed, such as:

- * Will an Emergency Location Transmitter (ELT) really help someone find me?
- * What are some of the "must haves" tools, equipment, and supplies that a pilot should have for every flight?
- * What other types of devices could help me in an emergency?
- * What types of medical equipment should I consider?

Parking is provided for free. Simply park in any of the numbered parking stalls in the Airport's pay parking lot, nothing further is required. No fee will be charged unless your vehicle remains overnight.

OGD AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

NORTH APRON RECONSTRUCTION

Thank you all for your patience in dealing with the annual construction cycle and the dust and inconvenience that it causes. The OGD North Apron Reconstruction project is now at substantial completion and available for use. I want to personally thank CB Aviation for their help in temporarily moving their ramp operations for the duration of this project. The taxilane that passes to the west of CB Aviation and Borsight will be reopened and available to taxiing once the surface is swept and the barricades removed.

I am also grateful for our very talented contractor, Granite Construction, who once again, successfully completed another difficult and invasive project at OGD.

DEMOLITION OF OLD AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER

At the same time, the old OGD Air Traffic Control Tower has been safely removed from the roof of the OGD Terminal Building and the current Air Traffic Control Tower. Additionally, the entire roof of the OGD Terminal Building has been replaced and the 30-year warranty has been affirmed to be intact after the tower's removal. This delicate and potentially dangerous project was successfully completed by Grant Mackay Demolition. They did a fabulous job and clean up. We will be repairing some of the pavement where they had to set some of the very heavy piece of the old tower.

OGD AIRPORT TERMINAL RESTAURANT REMODEL

Landmark Companies is the successful low bidder for the Bickering Sisters Restaurant Remodel. While the Bickering Sisters have been operating food services at the OGD Terminal Building for over a year, you cannot really say it is a full restaurant.
