

Utah Arts Alliance CONNECT Program

Connect is a free monthly pop-up art exhibit that invites all visual artists to showcase their art (up to two pieces). Helpful connections and friendships are made as artists learn skills necessary for art careers, gained through lectures, workshops, and activities. Attendees complete the evening by voting for their favorite art; an experience which helps prepare and educate the participating artists.

ARTS 2022

First Friday Art Stroll

The art stroll is held the first Friday of each month and was attended by an estimated 8,000 to 10,000 people throughout the year. Currently 20 locations are participating in the stroll with an additional 40 artist studios located inside of the Monarch. The following Pop Up events were programmed in the warmer months:

- 5 rotating events at The Corner & Union Station
- 2 Food trucks at Union Station – July & September
- 5 musicians / groups featured monthly in various locations



Public Art Projects

Dumke Arts Plaza & Ogden Ave.

The extension to the Dumke Arts Plaza was completed in summer 2022. The north end of Ogden Ave was converted into a programmable space that mirrors the length of the Dumke Arts Plaza. The road was leveled for better ease of programming like festivals, small concerts, food trucks and other arts-based events. Landscaping, lighting and bollards were installed to complete the project. The plaza and plaza extension will be home to arts-based programming, intimate concerts, poetry readings, outdoor theatre and more.

CORNER Plaza Project

New York based artist team Nancy and Josh Hou DeSousa have designed and are currently building a new art piece for the Corner Plaza redesign project located at the southwest corner of 25th and Washington. The original artwork design was changed to comply with legal and risk request. The project is now slated to be complete summer of 2023.



OGX BRT Public Art Project

The Arts Advisory Committee recommended \$190,000 in public art funding to place artwork on all of the glass panels of the new Bus Rapid Transit Station currently under construction across Ogden. City Council officially approved the use of these funds on December 14, 2021.

Ogden City in partnership with UTA and McKay Dee Hospital will place artwork on the thirteen BRT stations currently planned for the city. Artwork from artists and design teams will be installed on the glass



windscreens at the new Ogden Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Stations. This project will create a vibrant experience at each BRT Station stretching from Downtown Ogden to Weber State University and McKay Dee Hospital.

Through the process, the public art selection committee released an R.F.Q. seeking artwork that tells the story of our city and

connects people through creativity. 68 Submissions were received from local and national artists, and in December of 2021 ten artists were selected and assigned a station to work on. WSU selected their own 3 artists separately. It is the desire that this creative engagement project will enhance, inspire, and interact with the community, the BRT riders, the local neighborhoods, and Ogden's visitors. This project is slated for completion in late 2023.

Advisory Committee

The Ogden Arts Advisory Committee

This diverse group of people, representing all facets of the arts, performs a valuable service through and under the direction of Ogden City Arts in the areas of arts advocacy, administration of the Public Art program, the Arts Grants program and the Mayor's Awards in the Arts. They also oversee the First Friday Art Stroll and have helped with the implementation of the Master Plan for Arts and Culture adopted in 2017 and The Nine Rails Creative District Master Plan in 2018.

- Read and scored 24 grant applications and recommended \$139,980 of funding for 21 applicants
- Reviewed applications and selected a new Poet Laureate for Ogden
- Selected/oversaw 13 artists to complete artwork for the OGX Bus Rapid Transit Public Art Project. Artworks to be installed by UTA estimated completion fall of 2023
- Reviewed all nominations received and recommended the Mayor's Award Honorees
- Completed an annual review of the Master Plan for Arts and Culture
- Completed an annual review of the Nine Rails Creative District Master Plan
- Leon Araujo- At-Large member was awarded a Mayor's Award in the Arts for Emerging Artist
- Committee members represented Ogden City at the Ogden Arts Festival in June providing information on the arts in Ogden, a fun art project and treats.
- The committee collaborated to complete a painted sugar skull for Nurture the Creative Mind's Day of the Dead celebration. Leon Araujo was selected to design and paint the skull
- Currently compiling options for the next public art projects

Arts Grants

Ogden Arts Grants

\$139,980 in Arts Grants were awarded to 21 individuals and arts-based organizations. (with \$10,020 in funding rolling to FY23/24 cycle)

Arts Grants in Spanish

Two Arts Grants workshops were held to help grantees understand the program and process prior to applying. A Spanish translator was present and available at these workshops. Ogden Arts Grants applications are currently being translated into Spanish.



Ogden Poet Laureate Program



A new, was selected in May of 2022. After Mayoral approval, Angelika started her new term in July as the representative of Literary Arts for Ogden and the surrounding areas. Angelika is currently working on her new project "Love Letters to Ogden" that will be a community interactive installation located at the Corner Plaza. Installation is expected in February 2023.

Collaborative Art Projects

- Members of the ACE team helped Visit Ogden repair the mural in the Monroe tunnel multiple times due to vandalism.
- The Trail connector street and bridge painting project was completed in August. In collaboration with MarketStar employees, this project helps river parkway trail users connect from the Monroe tunnel to the trail behind Lorin Farr Park and vice versa.
