



Discounted Rainwater Barrels Now Available to Ogden Residents, Aiding Water Conservation

Ogden, UT— Ogden City is excited to partner once again with the Utah Rivers Council in an effort to bring our residents discounted American-made rain barrels as part of the RainHarvest program.

RainHarvest distributes barrels to Utah residents for the purpose of collecting rainwater that falls on rooftops for later use on lawns and gardens. This program offers residents the opportunity to affordably conserve water through rainwater collection. By purchasing these heavily discounted rain barrels, Utahns can reduce municipal water demand and improve the water quality of local streams, rivers, and lakes by decreasing polluted runoff.

Made in the U.S. of 100% recycled plastic, not only are these 50-gallon rain barrels an eco-conscious option for rainwater collecting but they are also user-friendly and one of the most popular options for rainwater collecting across the country. They come with a locking lid, a mosquito screen, a 3/4" valve that can be connected to a garden hose and linking capability to connect multiple barrels together.

A limited number of discounted rain barrels are available to Ogden residents through the RainHarvest program. Each household may order up to two barrels at the subsidized price of the \$57 through <http://www.rainwatersolutions.com/urc>. Once the discounted supply runs out, the public may still purchase rain barrels at their wholesale price of \$85. The sale window will remain open until late April. **Barrels will be distributed during a one-day pickup event on May 9th from 4pm-6pm at Weber State University.** Please note, rain barrels will not be shipped to residents.

To purchase a discounted barrel, Ogden residents will need to enter their address on the subsidy form on the website, after verification, residents will then be redirected to a page supplying the discount code to use towards the barrels. It is important to note that receiving a discount code is **not** confirmation of a purchase, buyers must complete the purchase process.
