



1.2 CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

- A. The Construction Contract is known as 23rd St - The Junction Intersection Improvements.

1.3 DEFINITIONS

- A. Suspended Contract Time: The Contract Time commences to run upon the day given in the Notice to Proceed. Suspended Contract Time means there is a period within the Contract Time where time is not counted. For purposes of this Construction Contract, the time period not counted may not be broken up into separate periods but shall be considered as only a one time period to be used to allow for work suspension due to just cause.

1.4 CONTRACT TIME

- A. Engineer has estimated 50 calendar days are required to substantially complete the work. The total number of days established by the Bidder to substantially complete the work is calendar days.
- B. If Bidder anticipates occurrence of Suspended Contract Time the number of calendar days of Suspended Contract Time anticipated is calendar days providing the Notice to Proceed date is given by the Engineer after .
- C. All work must be completed prior to the downtown construction moratorium. (11/22/2025).

Clarification Items:

The power to the previously removed bollards has been completely removed on three of the four corners. The NE corner has had the power capped at the furthest east bollard location and is currently live. Ogden City is working on removing the live power to the bollard, on the NE corner.

Contractor/bidder is not expected to address that item.

The as built drawings for the Junction are available.

The bollard's electrical layout is not correct on that plan, as the electrical work was completed after the as built drawings were produced.

Concrete color codes are identified on the plans, but where they are likely not readily available concrete colors, Ogden City is open to accepting alternate, readily available, concrete colors.

The concrete colors must be as close to the indicated color codes as possible.

The concrete colors must be approved by Ogden City prior to installation.

For coordination with the decorative streetlights (Pickup and inquiries) contact Jon Fraser (801-629-8271).

Concrete bench stamp/patterns are not required at time of bid opening.

Only three patterns are required to be submitted, but Ogden City reserves the right to request additional pattern proposals.

All four intersection corners (Corners, not roads) can be closed, but the pedestrian traffic plan must account for this and be approved by Ogden City.

Material storage and staging areas can be coordinated with Ogden City, but in no way can the BRT or 23rd St be obstructed.
