This addendum is issued to modify the previously released solicitation documents and/or given for informational purposes. It is hereby made part of the ITB document. It is made available to all interested and eligible parties via the Ogden City Purchasing website.

Scope of Work

Big Pool:

- Remove all existing plaster and rubber patch materials.
- Assess the exposed pool structure and repair any damage identified during removal.
- Install 2x2 tiles on both sides of the expansion joint.
- Install backer rod and seal the expansion joint with polysulfide.
- Strip, grind, and float the top steps; retile steps completely with new tile.
- Remove and save all salvageable tiles.
 - attach-Install all new tiles along the edge of the pool using Schluter edge system.
(existing tile)
 - Ensure all tile edging is smooth and safe, with no sharp edges.

- Install depth transition tile.
- Install new pool drains.
- Knock in return fittings and perform leak detection.
- Install **PebbleQuartz®** Quarts Finish upon completion of structural and tile work.
- Conduct full wet testing to confirm watertight integrity and performance.

Little Pool:

- attachInstall all new tiles along the edge of the pool using Schluter edge system.
(existing tile)
- Ensure all tile edging is smooth and safe, with no sharp edges.

New Tiles:

- The selected tile product must be approved by the project manager prior to installation. It should closely match the existing pool tile color and pattern.
