Public Safety Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) System

Q & A

- 1) Please provide details on the number of cameras that vendors should propose and price.
 - a) Proposals should account for 41 cameras, 40 fixed and 1 on a camera trailer.
- 2) Has the City identified specific locations where the LPR cameras will be installed?
 - a) Yes, existing camera locations will be utilized.
- 3) Is the necessary infrastructure (e.g., poles and power) available at the City's identified locations or should vendors propose these elements, as well?
 - a) Infrastructure is already in place.
- 4) Has the City established general requirements for each location, such as speed detection capabilities, lane coverage, and direct AC or solar-powered cameras?
 - a) Yes.
- 5) Will any of the identified locations require obtaining permits or permissions?
 - a) No.
- 6) Has the City defined a deployment timeline?
 - a) Currently planning towards the end of November, beginning of December. Nothing more defined than that currently.
- 7) Please provide details on the RTCC software the City currently uses.
 - a) Currently no RTCC software is used in conjunction with the ALPR cameras. Internal analysts conducting all work and interactions with cameras and footage.
- 8) Does the City plan to expand its current LPR system or replace their existing system?
 - a) There may be some expansion in the future, but the current plan is to replace the existing system.
