**Public Safety Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) System**

**Q & A**

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1. During the meeting, it was stated that all the cameras were on poles and solar powered. In Q&A #3 question #4, it's stated they're a combination of attached to poles and buildings. Please clarify.
  - a. Initial review had several cameras shown as secured to buildings. It was later determined they were moved to poles.
2. Regardless if poles or buildings, please clarify if cameras are mounted beyond 10 feet and would need any type of requirements beyond standard ladders such as:
  - a. Bucket truck
  - b. Scissor lift
  - i. Cameras are currently mounted on 12-foot poles.
3. Is this RFP seeking a solution that includes two types of cameras – ALPR cameras *AND* fixed position surveillance cameras, or is this strictly seeking ALPR cameras?
  - a. We are only seeking ALPR cameras at this time.
4. Based on information provided on the City's pre-proposal conference, it is our understanding that the City intends to use existing poles for this project. To ensure compatibility with the proposed cameras, please provide vendors with the existing poles' specifications.
  - a. The poles in use are 2.8" in diameter with 12 feet above grade.
