1. Pricing Adjustments During Initial 2-Year Term

The RFB states that the contract will have an initial two-year term with an optional one-year extension. Can you please confirm whether price adjustments are allowed at any point during the initial two-year period (e.g., fuel surcharges, raw-material cost escalations, inflationary adjustments, etc.)?

If adjustments are allowed, is there a defined process or timeline for requesting them?

a. Consistent with Utah State Cooperative and City contracts, Ogden City wants vendors to lock-in pricing for the initial contract period. Vendors should forecast and submit firm rates. Request for price adjustment must be submitted directly to the Recreation team. It must include documented justification and supporting materials, particularly for significant adjustments. All requests are subject to City review and approval process. No specific timeline is guaranteed.

2. Contract Start Date

Is there an anticipated contract start date following the December 18 bid opening and evaluation?

a. Considering the bid opening and contract processing, the anticipated start date for delivery is January 6, 2026. However, delivery of product may be required sooner, pending City contract process.

3. Warranty Terms

On the bid submission page, there is a section requesting warranty terms. Typically, we include an appendix document that spells out our full warranty information. Can we include this with our bid, without being in violation of the bid terms?

a. Yes, you can include warranty terms in the appendix without violating bid terms.
