

OGDEN DOG PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- * The Dog Park is open one hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset.
- * Park users shall adhere to provisions set forth in Title 13 of the Ogden Municipal Code.
- * Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them. Aggressive dogs are not permitted. If your dog becomes aggressive, leash your dog and exit the park immediately.
- * Always dispose of your dog's waste in the trash receptacles. If waste accumulates, the park will close for health and safety reasons.
- * Each owner is permitted to bring no more than two (2) dogs at a time. You must supervise your dog(s) at all times and have a leash, no longer than 6 feet, on hand for each of your dogs at all times.
- * Dogs must be wearing proof of current vaccinations, licenses and identification tags at all times. Dog(s) must be current on routine inoculations, healthy, and free of parasites and communicable diseases.
- * Puppies under four months of age and female dogs in heat are not permitted in the park.
- * No dog food or treats, human food, glass containers, or smoking allowed. (fights may occur over food, and dogs may get sick from eating foods that are not part of their usual diet)
- * Permits are required for organized events.
- * Dog grooming, professional dog training or the sale of goods or services is prohibited without written permission from Ogden City. Any dog training with dog food or treats is absolutely prohibited.
- * Vending, selling or giving away of animals is prohibited without written permission from Ogden City.
- * When leaving designated Dog Park areas, dog owners must leash their dog(s) and continue to observe all park and local animal control laws.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES & ETIQUETTE

- * Parents are discouraged from bringing children under 12 years of age to the park. Children should be supervised carefully, and at no time should children run with or chase after dogs.
- * Please limit your visit to one hour during times of peak use.
- * First time users should visit the park during non-peak times. This will help your dog adjust to the new experience.
- * Please remove spiked collars, choke chains, prong or metal collars from your dog to prevent injury to other dogs during play.
- * Please refrain from entering in a gate that is blocked or heavily crowded by other dogs and owners. Call your dog(s) away from gate areas when others are trying to enter or exit.
- * Let your dog off leash as soon as you arrive - leashed dogs may feel threatened when off-leash dogs greet them.
- * Please refrain from leaving behind used items, such as toys, watering bowls, leashes, etc. this can unintentionally spread disease or illness.
- * Keep walking. This keeps the park neutral territory.
- * Fill any hole your dog digs. Both dogs and people may be injured by stepping into holes.
- * Dog owners must be in the park, within view, and be able to maintain voice control of their dog(s) at all times.
- * Site maintenance needs will vary based on weather and use. You may be asked to vacate the park during maintenance activities. Areas of the park or the entire park may be closed due to weather or maintenance needs.
- * Violators will be subject to removal from the park and suspended of park privileges.

BY APPROACHING AND ENTERING THIS PARK EACH PERSON AGREES THAT:

Use of the Ogden City Dog Park constitutes acknowledgement (i.e. the human users agree and admit) that: (1) The user is aware of and understands all risks and dangers involved with being around and controlling canines. (2) The user voluntarily chooses to accept the risks of injuries and/or damages to themselves, their property, and their dogs. (3) Users agree that the City of Ogden and its agents, officers, employees, and volunteers are NOT responsible for and will NOT be liable for any injuries and/or damages to users, their property, or their dogs. (4) Users agree to make no claim nor bring any lawsuit against the City and its officers, agents, employees and volunteers for any injuries and/or damages to themselves, their property or their dogs resulting from the use of the Ogden City Dog Park or other City property.
