- Advises both the mayor and the council, represents the city in legal proceedings, reviews and maintains contracts and agreements, and manages the city's prosecutors

## **Management Services:**

- Budget and Fiscal Operations, Human Resources, Recorder, Fleet & Facilities, Information Technology, Risk Management, and Justice Court

## **Public Services:**

- Parks, Cemetery, Recreation, Engineering, Golf Courses, Streets, Water Utility, Sewer Utility, and Sanitation Operations

## **Fire:**

- Prevention, Rescue, Operations, Training, Rescue, Ambulance Services, and Emergency Management

## **Police:**

- Support Services, Uniform, Traffic, Real Time Crime Center, Investigations, School Resource Officers (SRO), Animal Services, and Crossing Guards

## **Community & Economic Development (CED)**

- Community Development, Economic Development, Business Development, Planning, Building Services, Code Services (Enforcement), Arts, Culture & Events, Airport, and Business Depot Ogden (BDO/DDO Reuse)

## City Administration

### Roles & Responsibilities:

- The administration is the executive branch
- Implements the laws passed by the City Council
- Manages day-to-day operations
- Develops and proposes an annual budget and Capital Improvement Plan
- Public Safety: Police and Fire
- Public Services: Utilities, Streets, Parks, Recreation, etc.
- Administration Functions: Human Resources, IT, Finance, Records, etc.
- Responds to the needs of residents
- The mayor also acts as:
  - Redevelopment Agency Executive Director
  - Municipal Building Authority President

## City Council

### Roles & Responsibilities:

- The Council is the legislative branch
- Establishes laws and policies
- Adopts/amends the city's budget
- Provides advice and consent for certain city positions and boards/committees
- Determines tax rates and fees
- Conducts financial and management audits
- Approves resolutions and ceremonial recognitions
- Responds to the needs of residents
- The Council also acts as:
  - Redevelopment Agency
  - Municipal Building Authority
  - Board of Canvassers



## City Council

### About the Council:

- Seven-member Council
- Four Municipal District and three At-Large Representatives
- Each serves a four-year term
- Elections are held in odd numbered years, i.e. 2021, 2023, 2025
- Council members are part-time
- Council chair and vice chair are nominated and then elected from the current Council each year
