## Emergency Preparedness: Getting Involved

**The best way to be effective in a community-wide response is to be a trained and informed volunteer that can help take action to support emergency response.** Here are three ways to prepare individuals and families to respond and help the community in a natural disaster.

- **Prepare at home:** Make or update a preparedness plan (evacuation, communication, family disaster, etc.), build or update a preparedness kit, talk to neighbors or co-workers about emergency preparedness and look up hazards in the area and what to do about them.
- **VOAD Training:** VOADs (Volunteer Organization Active in Disaster) are a coalition of non-profit organizations that respond to disasters and provide training and opportunities for experience in disaster response.

- **CERT Training:** Taking a CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) class helps to educate volunteers on basic disaster skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization and disaster medical operations. Register online for the next local class beginning in September.
